

## Driving restrictions, goods transport Latvia

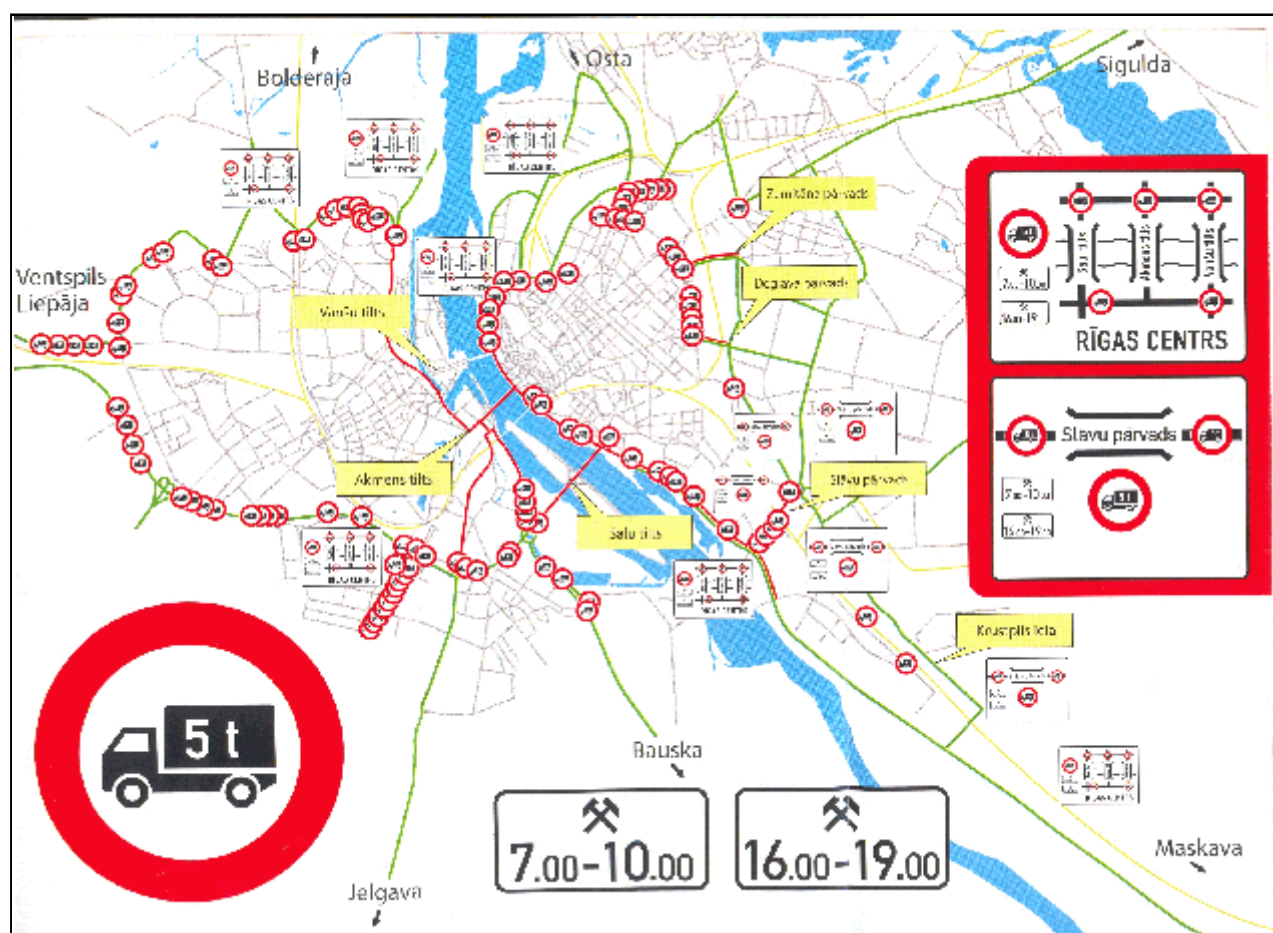
### **National restrictions:**

There are no driving restrictions on goods vehicles at weekends or on public holidays.

### **Local restrictions - City of Riga**

Since 1 December 2007, driving restrictions on trucks of over 5t have been in force from Monday to Friday, from 07h00 to 10h00 and from 16h00 to 19h00 on the following streets of the city of Riga:

- the Stone Bridge (Akmens tilts), the Island Bridge (Salu tilts) and all streets leading to these bridges, i.e. Daugavgrivas Street, Vienibas Avenue, Akmenu Street, Valguma Street, Uzvaras blvd, Mukusalas Street, 11 Novembra Street, Eksporta Street.
- the Slavu Bridge (Slavu parvads), Deglava Street bridge (Deglava parvads) and Zemitana bridge (Zemitana parvads). Trucks are, however, allowed to use the Slavu ringroad. In order to avoid the Slavu bridge, trucks should use Krustpils Street.
